Dear Year 12 IB Students and Parents,

This outlines the procedures for accessing your final IB results for the November 2025 examination session and provides important information regarding remarking and your IB Admission Score (IBAS).

Accessing Your IB Results

Each student has been sent a unique personal PIN via email to access their IB results. If you also sat for the May 2025 examination session, please use the new PIN for November 2025 instead of your previous PIN.

Steps to access your results:

- 1. Visit the IB results website at https://candidates.ibo.org.
- 2. Copy and paste the PIN you received in an email from the Curriculum Office directly from the attachment in the email. Typing the PIN may result in errors due to its unique characters.
- 3. Ensure there are no extra spaces before or after the PIN when pasting it into the login field.

Important Notes:

- After three incorrect login attempts, your account will be locked for 30 minutes. Additional attempts within this period will restart the 30-minute lockout.
- It is recommended to access the results on a laptop for optimal performance.
- While the IB recommends Firefox as the preferred browser, the results system should also work with Chrome and Safari.

Release of Results

Your IB results will be available from **8am** on **Wednesday**, **17 December 2025**. The results may be released in staggered intervals to accommodate time zone differences, so please be patient during this process.

Component Reports

Your subject-specific component reports (detailed breakdowns of marks) will be available shortly after your results. In some cases, it may take up to 24 hours. These reports must be downloaded by the IB Coordinator, who will then email them to you individually. Component reports provide detailed results for individual exam papers (e.g., Paper 1, Paper 2, and/or Paper 3).



IBAS Score (ATAR Equivalent)

Your IBAS score will be sent to your registered personal email address by **UAC** on **Thursday 18 December 2025.** If you do not receive your IBAS score, please contact Ms Renwick for assistance.

For reference, the updated IB score-to-IBAS conversion chart for 2025 is available on the <u>UAC website</u>. Please note that the conversion adjustments may result in slightly lower IBAS scores, which is an issue IB Coordinators are addressing with UAC.

Remarking Process

Once you receive your results, you can choose to:

- 1. Accept the awarded result as final, or
- 2. Apply for a remark of your exam papers or eCoursework.

Key Details about Remarking:

- **Cost:** A Category 1 remark costs 153 Singapore dollars per subject (approximately 175 AUD).
- Mandatory: Written consent is required by the student's legal guardian(s) when making this request. If a grade is lowered, the original grade will not be reinstated.
- **Outcome:** Remarking may result in your grade **going up** or **down**. Internal Assessments and moderated tasks are excluded from this process.
- **Eligibility:** If you are within 1-2 marks of the next grade boundary, a remark may be worthwhile. If successful, you will not be charged for the remark.
- All components of the subject are remarked. For example, for Biology they will remark Paper 1, Paper 2 & Paper 3. A student cannot choose only one section of the paper e.g. French HL paper 1 writing to be remarked. They must remark all of the exam papers for French HL.
- The IB will not remark Internal Assessments and any tasks that have been moderated. The re-moderation process can only occur if there is at least a 15% difference between the teacher's raw mark and the IB's moderated marks. As remoderation is by the subject, it is the school's decision if the re-moderation process is applied. Please note, in the re-moderation process the students mark can only stay the same or go up. A student's mark cannot go down during remoderation.
- If your mark does change during the remark process your IBAS will be recalculated by UAC and Ms Renwick will email you your updated IBAS score.



Deadlines:

- The IB remarking window opens with the release of results and closes at **9am** on **Friday 19 December 2025.**
- A second window will reopen at **11.01am on Friday 2 January 2026.** Processing of remark forms will occur from **Monday 5 January 2026.**
- To ensure timely updates for university offers, it is advisable to submit any remark requests as early as possible.

Submission: If you decide to proceed with a remark, please complete the attached form and return it to Ms Renwick by **Tuesday 24 February 2026.**

Final Note

The Category 1 re-mark process typically concludes within three days, but can take up to eighteen days, with any updated IBAS scores recalculated and sent to you promptly. We wish you all the best for the remainder of the IB Diploma Programme and in your future endeavours beyond school.
