**Date:** Friday 27 March 2026  
**Time:** 6.30pm until 9.30pm; Doors open at 6:00pm  
Doors will close at 7.00pm and no student will be allowed to leave the premise until the finish time unless pre-arranged by the Year Coordinator and a parent/carer  
**Venue:** St Patrick's College Hall (access via Francis Street, Strathfield)  
**Cost:** \$30.00 per ticket (includes a drink and a packet of chips)  
**Tickets Sold:** One ticket per student. From 3.45pm Wednesday 11 March until 9.00am Thursday 19 March

**Admission:** Valid Dance ticket and Student photo ID card

Full security will be provided to ensure a safe environment and there will be teachers and senior students present in a supervisory capacity. Students will not be permitted to chew gum. Cloakroom facilities will be available. Naturally, security and safety of students are paramount, and for this reason the following conditions and student expectations have been put in place:

- All tickets must be pre-purchased by 9.00am Thursday 19 March; NO tickets will be on sale at the door.
- You may give your permission and purchase a ticket for your daughter to attend by using the Humanitix platform:

- Each attending student must present their school photo ID card along with their printed ticket from the online sale to gain entry.
- Parents and/or students are not to purchase tickets for their daughter (or girls from other schools) from any other school allocation. This will be monitored during the purchasing period.
- All students are required to conduct themselves according to the St Patrick's College expectations of respect for self, others and property.
- Students must comply with any requests by supervising adults or senior students. Parents will be phoned and asked to collect their daughter in the event of any serious discrepancies re: behaviour, identity or inappropriate dress.
- Appropriate dress is required i.e., smart casual. NO crop tops or thongs allowed.
- Enclosed shoes must be worn (no heels allowed).
- No illegal substances i.e. cigarettes, vapes, alcohol or drugs are to be brought onto the premises and/or be consumed before or during the dance. The College reserves the right to search for prohibited items.
- All phones will be collected and cloaked on entry and returned once the students are dismissed.
- Prior to the evening students are asked to arrange appropriate transport home from the venue immediately following the conclusion of the dance.
- This event will be held in accordance with any current NSW Health COVID-19 Public Health Orders and in accordance with school policies and procedures. In purchasing their daughter a ticket parents acknowledge and accept that there is a risk that their daughter may be exposed to COVID-19 whilst attending and participating at this event. Parents will confirm that their daughter will not attend if displaying any symptoms of illness, and/or directed to isolate under public health orders.

Thank you for your assistance in the preparation of the dance. We look forward to a very enjoyable evening for both the girls and boys.
