Re: Round Square Tour 2026: Experience Adventure, Service and an International Connection

MLC School is pleased to invite Year 10 and Year 11 students to apply to represent our community as delegates on a Round Square Tour to North Queensland.

Whilst the main Round Square International Conference will be held in Sydney, Australia, we are offering students to join combined overseas delegation in exploring the Great barrier Reef and Daintree Rainforest. This is a unique opportunity for students to participate in a full week program of hands on experiences, designed to deepen their understanding of the Round Square IDEALS: Internationalism, Democracy, Environmentalism, Adventure, Leadership and Service.

Student delegates will take part in a rewarding and challenging experience that fosters independence, emotional resilience, self-esteem, intercultural understanding and leadership capacity.

As part of the package, delegates will be provided meals and placed in shared accommodation with other student participants for the five-day tour. Further event details, including flight details, supervision arrangements and logistics, will be provided to selected families. Personal spending money, and any incidental expenses not included in the official conference packages is the responsibility of students and parents.

Participants remain MLC School students throughout the conference and are expected to uphold the highest standards of conduct as ambassadors of our school. Delegates must be prepared to engage positively with peers from diverse backgrounds and to share their experience both formally and informally with the MLC School community on their return.

Be advised that this Post Conference Tour to North Queensland is dependent on the registration of our international delegation. If the minimum number of international delegates is not reached, the tour will not proceed.

Application Procedure

Interested students are asked to complete the attached online application form by the stated deadline.

Please note that applications may exceed available places. Where this occurs, preference will be given to students who can demonstrate clear understanding of, and active involvement in, the Round Square IDEALS and broader school life.

Once delegate places are confirmed, families will receive the official conference permission documentation and be required to complete all pre-departure requirements by the stated deadlines. This includes submitting signed student and parent/carer Code of Conduct forms, providing relevant dietary and medical information, confirming valid travel documents, and paying the required deposit to secure the delegate place. Families will also receive key program logistics and transport guidance.
