



Spawtz information portal – information for students and families

The Spawtz competition management system provides all the information you'll need for the IGSA Sport badminton, tennis, touch football, water polo, basketball, football, hockey and netball competitions. You have a one stop shop to find out where a team is playing, who they're playing against and how they've been going throughout the season, as well as how to find out if a venue is open or closed. This information will help you throughout the IGSA Sport season; if you need any other information about a team or a fixture, your school's sport department will be best placed to answer those questions.

Everything can be found via the dashboard page – to get there, simply type the following into your browser.

How to find out fixture information, results and tables

To find out information about an upcoming fixture, results or the current table, you'll need to know one of two things – either the specific team number or the grade in which the team plays.

- Specific team number: each team has a unique code, which is made up of the 3-letter school-specific codes followed by two numbers i.e. 'ABC09' or 'ZYX18'.
- Team grade: grades are split into 3 divisions; Senior (usually year 10, 11 and 12 students), Junior (usually year 8 and 9 students), and year 7 (year 7 students only)

Using a team number:

- From the dashboard page above, click on 'Find your team'
- Type in the 3-letter, 2-number team number and click 'Search'. In some cases, your school may have multiple teams with the same 3-letter, 2-number code – for example, if your school is playing in all 4 competitions that term, they will have an 'ABC01' team in all sports (e.g. ABC01-Basketball, ABC01-Tennis, etc).
- From there, you can select the sport that corresponds to the team you want, or you'll be taken straight to the team profile page.
- This page will have the fixtures and results for the current season, and you can click 'Back to standings' to see the current table for the competition.

Using a grade:

- From the dashboard page above, click on 'View fixtures and standings'
- Find your grade by first using the sport-specific subheadings, followed by the grade you're looking for.
- From here, you can click 'Fixtures' or 'Standings':
 - o The 'Fixtures' page will display all upcoming fixtures and results from previous matches in the current season.
 - o The 'Standings' page will show you the current table for the competition.

How to find out if a venue is open or closed, and map links for each venue

From the dashboard page, click 'Venue Closures'. This will take you to a page listing all the venues in use that week, sorted on a per sport basis. It is important that you ensure that you are looking under the correct sport, as some of our sports use the same venue for multiple sports.

In some circumstance, there may be a comment regarding a venue, e.g. a partial closure.

As always, once a venue is closed, it will not reopen that weekend.

From this page, you can click on your venue to open up a Google Map link with the specific location of the venue.
