A vision screening is a series of short tests, providing an overview of your child's vision, involving:

- Vision Measurement** To ensure your child's vision is within the expected range for their age group
- Eye Muscle Testing** To ensure your child's eye muscles are aligned and working together
- Colour Vision Screening** To assess for a colour vision deficiency

The results of the vision screening are strictly confidential. Your child's name and date of birth will be provided during the screening; however, no personal details will be retained by Specsavers [store].
