





Research - Some General Strategies





Different Qualifications

Diploma; An external award that requires 1 year of study

Degree: An external award that requires 3-4 years full time study

Double Degree: Allows you to complete two degree in less time usually 1 additional year to single degree





Application Processes

UAC – University Admissions Centre (Manages all applications NSW)



Rymble Ladies' Applying to Uni

ATAR: Rank position in state universities used for entrance into courses

Selection Rank = ATAR + Adjustment factors

What are Adjustment Factors:

- Subject bonus points (automatic calculation)
- Elite athlete/performer
- Location e.g. MQ
- Duke of Ed
- EAS
- Note that maximums apply
