

About Jump Start

The Multiplex Jump Start Program is a unique mentoring initiative designed by Multiplex women, to give female high-school students a holistic view of the construction industry, and the diverse range of career pathways it has to offer.

Students will be given the opportunity to join the Multiplex delivery team on an iconic project – NEXTDC S3.

Commencing in 2023, the 6-month curriculum is made up of interactive discipline-based workshops, panel discussions with industry leaders, site walks and mentoring sessions.

The benefits of the Jump Start program include:

- Personal development
- Broadening knowledge of the built environment
- Connecting with industry professionals and like-minded students
- One-on-one mentoring
- Membership of the Jump Start program alumni
- A direct pathway to Multiplex's Work Experience Program and the Graduate Assessment Centre.

Eligibility

- This program is designed for female senior high school students (Years 9–12) within the local catchment area.
- Eagerness to commit to attending all sessions held throughout the year

Time Commitment

- 15-30 min Introduction to the Jump Start Program
- 2-3 hour Workshop (out of school hours)
- 1-3 hour Panel discussion

Jump Start was piloted on the 1 Denison Street Project in North Sydney, resulting in 9 out of 13 students enrolling in a degree related to the built environment including Project Management, Interior Design, Architecture and Engineering, and four industry-based scholarships. The program is now being rolled out across major Multiplex projects throughout Australia.
