Pymble North embankment maintenance

From Saturday 26 August to Sunday 27 August 2023

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking embankment stabilisation works along a railway cutting north of Pymble Station from Saturday 26 August to Sunday 27 August.

We are spraying concrete to cover the face of the railway embankment, reducing the risk of embankment slips and disrupting rail operations.

Please note all the required environmental approvals have been obtained and relevant environmental guidelines will be followed.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise over the weekend.
- **Weekend work will take place between 6am and 7pm on Saturday 26 August and Sunday 27 August.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Work vehicles and heavy vehicles will be using Avon Road to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be restricted near worksites.


