These awards are for Secondary Students only and are inclusive of Term 4, 2022 to Term 3, 2023.

## Official of the Year (Nomination by Sports Co-ordinator and Head Coach)

- Represents College values at all times
- Actively involved with a College sport as an official
- Consistently performs at a high level
- Demonstrates commitment to continuous improvement

# Team of the Year (Saturday Sport team – Nomination by Sports Co-ordinator and Head Coach)

This award is presented to the most successful Saturday Sport team. The team must also satisfy the following criteria:

- Represents the College values at all competitions
- Demonstrates outstanding sportsmanship and team spirit
- Consistently performs at a high level

# Representative Team of the Year (Carnival or Representative team – Nomination by Sports Coordinator and Head Coach)

This award is presented to the most successful representative team. The team must also satisfy the following criteria:

- Represents the College values at all competitions
- Demonstrates outstanding sportsmanship and team spirit
- Consistently performs at a high level

# Australian Representatives (Induction onto the Honour Board – Nomination by Sports Co-ordinator and Head Coach)

This award is presented to students who have been selected in an Australian team that has competed in an international competition:

- Australian Junior Team
- Australian Open Team

# All' Ultimo Lavoro – Strive for the Highest Awards (Limited number per sport - Nomination by Sports Co-ordinator and Head Coach)

- Represents the College values at all times
- Strives to accept challenges through participation and to grow from her involvement in sport
- Exceptional role model for the College and *Pymble* sport
- Demonstrates outstanding sportsmanship
- Demonstrates a personal commitment to training and individual skill development





# Athlete of the Year (Nomination by Sports Co-ordinator and Head Coach)

This award is presented to students who are the best performers in their sport. Each student must also satisfy the following criteria:

- Is an active member of the Pymble Ladies' College team
- Consistently performs at a high level
- Considered an outstanding and valuable player on the College/school team
- Demonstrates outstanding leadership qualities and school team spirit
- Consistently shows a positive attitude and enthusiastic approach
- Displays a consistent level of commitment to the school team

### All-rounder of the Year (One per year group – Nomination by Head of Sport 7 to 12)

This award is presented to students who best display a high level of skill in a range of sports. Each student must also satisfy the following criteria:

- Participates in three or more sports at the College
- Is a member of top Pymble teams in those sports
- Has exemplary participation in competition and at training
- Demonstrates outstanding leadership qualities and displays College values
- · Shows a willingness to work with coaches and students as directed

# **Australian Olympic Change-Maker award (Nomination by Director of Sport)**

The Australian Olympic Change-Maker program recognises and rewards up to two students who are demonstrating the Olympic spirit through leadership and driving positive change in their communities. This award is presented to students who:

- Displaying leadership through sport in their school or local community.
- Using sport as a vehicle to improve health and wellbeing and drive social change in their school or local community.
- Demonstrates outstanding leadership qualities and displays College values

#### Para Athlete of the Year (Nomination by Director of Sport)

This award is presented to a student who has satisfied most, but not necessarily all, of the following criteria:

- Performs at the highest standard in their chosen College based sport(s)
- Represents Pymble in their sport(s)
- Considered an ambassador for the school and the sport
- Demonstrates outstanding sportsmanship
- Demonstrates a personal commitment to training and individual skill development

### **Sportswoman of the Year (Nomination by Director of Sport)**

This award is presented to a Year 12 student who has satisfied most, but not necessarily all, of the following criteria:

- Performs at the highest standard in their chosen College based sport(s)
- Represents *Pymble* in their sport(s)
- Considered an ambassador for the school and the sport
- Demonstrates outstanding sportsmanship
- Demonstrates a personal commitment to training and individual skill development



Ruth Hackney Memorial Award for Contribution to an igsa sport representative team (Nomination to igsa by Head of Sport (7-12); awarded by igsa)

This is awarded to Year 12 students who have been selected in an igsa sport team in 2023 and on three previous occasions in the same sport during their Secondary School years. A total of four representations, the final one being in Year 12 2023.
